Job Description:

The Utility Worker (Wastewater) is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all wastewater system lines and equipment, including pumps, meters, meter boxes, valves, and services; collects samples; responds to and resolves customer inquiries regarding service, repairs, or billing issues; performs general maintenance of grounds and facilities. This position is located in Keauhou, Hawaii (Big Island).

### **KUKIO**

### Job Description:

The Utility Worker is responsible for field operations and maintenance work and performs relief work under various classifications in the water and wastewater field. The work is performed under direct supervision and also requires the exercise of independent judgment and initiative. The nature of the work performed requires that an employee in this class establish and maintain effective working relationships with others. This position is located at Kukio in North Kona, HI.

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Operates and maintains HWS owned potable water treatment, potable water distribution, waste water collection and traditional and reuse waste water treatment systems.
- Performs work safely by adhering to OSHA & Cal Water Safety programs and policies as well as reporting hazards and unsafe conditions to supervisor.
- · Performs basic computer and mobile device functions for communication, data collection and entry.
- · Communicates with supervisor, co-workers, and customer service staff on a daily basis via phone communications, text, and email.
- · Completes customer service Job orders in a timely manner.
- Be available for after hour emergency call-out, weekend and holiday work schedule. (Emergency after-hour on-call program is managed and responsibility is rotated between available utility system operators on a weekly basis.)
- Collects, analyze, and record data, from potable water and waste water treatment plants, potable water and waste water pump stations, and potable water storage facilities, via computer and on-site visit.
  Calculate pump runtimes and chemical dosing, monitor water usage, treatment plant performance, suggest and make adjustments to equipment settings and perform maintenance cleaning as approved by utility system supervisor/DRC.
- · Uses analytical lab equipment, including spectrophotometer, electrode probes, scales, ovens, burners, lab glass ware, etc. Collects water and waste water samples, analyzes or packages and delivers to lab.
- Uses hand and power tools, including wrenches, ratchets, screw and nut drivers, hammers, pry bars, circular and reciprocating saws, welders, torches, picks, rakes, shovels, digging rods, metal detectors, etc.
- Operates and maintains gas, diesel, and electric, powered company vehicles and machinery, trucks,
  UTVs, skid steer, excavator, front loader, back hoe, fail mower, air compressor, portable power
  generator, portable pumps, vacuums, demolition hammer, chemical sprayers, etc.
- Installs, maintains, repairs pumps, valves, flow meters, pipe, tubing, and fittings in a range of sizes between ¼" to 16".
- Troubleshoots, evaluates, and assesses water and waste water leaks and equipment failure/damage.
  Develops repair strategies with supervisor.
- · Repairs water and wastewater mainline and service laterals and appurtenances, including all functions.
- · Manages and maintains supply inventory for operations office, treatment plants, and remote facilities. Includes equipment spare parts, treatment and lab chemical, general maintenance, etc.
- · Vegetation management and grounds keeping: Herbicide application, flail mow, weed whack, and trash removal.
- · Maintains fire hydrants, flushes water mains, exercises valves, repaints fire hydrants, tests fire hydrant performance, and logs maintenance data for record keeping.
- Reads and maintains water meters, maintains valve boxes and vaults; cleans roots, debris, and insect/rodent nest, uncovers buried meters and isolation valves, logs maintenance data for record keeping.
- · Inspects and flushes sewer manhole, removes debris, records condition of manhole and maintenance data for record keeping.

- Maintains sewer pump station and odor control system, tests alarm, inspects wet well, removes debris, and washes down. Replaces and recharges carbon.
- Maintains wastewater in vaults and lift stations
- · Operates and maintains reverse osmosis water treatment plant

- · Cleans and paints station and treatment plant equipment and appurtenances.
