

Water Circuit Rider – Temporary

The Hawai'i Rural Water Association (HRWA) is currently seeking a qualified individual for the HRWA Water Circuit Rider position. This position is temporary until October 2018, pending renewal of the program.

A HRWA Water Circuit Rider provides technical, managerial and financial assistance to water utility personnel regarding daily operations of a drinking water distribution system and/or water treatment facility. Qualified applicants shall possess knowledge of public water system operations and maintenance to provide rural and small municipal water systems on-site technical training/assistance to ensure cost effective operations and sustainable utility management within the state of Hawaii and the other geographical jurisdictions. The Circuit Rider position requires extensive travel within the State of Hawai'i, and American Territories. Qualified applicants should possess, at a minimum, education equivalent to graduation from high school and multi-year experience (preferably a minimum of 5 years) in operating and/or managing a public water system.
