**O wai Kou inoa? What is your water source?**

The water source is Waikū and the mountain in which these waters come from is Hualalai and Mauna Loa. In Kahalu'u, there is a significant presence of Heiau (temples) in which our Ali'i (chiefs) built around existing water sources. These temples were built around these water sources to be in tune with the Akua (god), where ever the water source exist the Akua resides. If you want to learn from this storied land of Kahalu'u we encourage you to engage in some healthy discussions on how the ancients treated and respected their sources of wai.
