

Covid-19 and HRWA

Because of the requirement to be home and abide by social distancing to reduce contact between individuals, HRWA is working with virtual training platforms such as GoToMeeting to continue to provide training. Sessions can be either at a single location with one computer/projector or set-up with multiple computer logins, eliminating the need for staff to be grouped together. Training sessions are recommended to be 2 and a half hours in duration but can be tailored to suit your company needs.

If you have staff at home, these training sessions are a good way for them to gain knowledge and give some work-purpose, filling their day.
